- Construct effective written requests for medical investigations
- Support safe complementary medicine health care practice by effectively obtaining medical review of high-risk clinical presentations (red flags).

### **Course Structure**

Participants will be provided with selected readings on communicating health information and interprofessional communication prior to listening to a series of five lecturettes. Each lecturette will be followed by a prescribed practice exercise and a multi-choice quiz. A personalised certificate of completion will be available to all students who pass.

#### **Guiding Principles**

Students will also receive the *Interprofessional Communications Guiding Principles* which includes a suite of letter templates to guide communication with doctors.
